is an ensemble based in Sussex and Hampshire specialising in the performance of music of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries using the styles, techniques and instruments of the period. Founded in 1982, they have given over 150 concerts in the area.

Judy Tarling, now in her ninth season as leader of the Consort, enjoys an international reputation in early music as leader of The Parley of Instruments and as former principal viola of The Hanover Band, a post she held for twenty years. Her first book 'Baroque String Playing for ingenious learners' (2000) has become the standard text on the subject and is read world-wide.

Ian Graham-Jones has made a study of baroque music for many years. While working in Cornwall he ran an annual summer festival of baroque music. His many articles and publications include the symphonies of John Marsh and Alice Mary Smith, and he has played harpsichord continuo in the Consort since its inception.
